SUBJECT: Appointments to Boards and Committees

Attached are my recommendations for five new appointments to City of Mesa Advisory Boards and Committees.

**Design Review Board** – Seven-member board with one new appointment.

New Appointment:  
Dan Maldonado, District 5. Mr. Maldonado is a licensed landscape architect with The Design Element. He holds a bachelor of science in landscape architecture from Arizona State University. Mr. Maldonado has worked in the region for over a decade and served on the City of Mesa Landscaping Regulations Review Committee in June of 2009. His term will expire June 30, 2012.

**Library Advisory Board** – Nine-member board with one new appointment.

New Appointment:  
Cameron Behning, District 2. Mr. Behning is a student at the Arizona School for the Arts and has volunteered at the Main Library for over three years logging 500 hours of service. He wants to serve his community as the Library Board’s student representative. His term will expire June 30, 2011.

**Museum & Cultural Advisory Board** – Eleven-member board with three new appointments.

New Appointments:  
Victor Linoff, District 4. Mr. Linoff is a retailer with Those Were the Days. He attended the University of Minnesota and has a background in theater, broadcasting, arts and museums. Mr. Linoff also has a long history of community service. His term will expire June 30, 2012.

Vincent DiBella, District 5. Mr. DiBella is an architect with Saemisch Di Bella Architects, Inc. He has a bachelor of science in architectural studies from Arizona State University. Mr. DiBella has served on the Downtown Mesa Association board, Downtown Development Committee and Design Review Board. He currently serves on the Planning and Zoning board. His term will expire June 30, 2012.

Robbi Venditti, District 3. Dr. Venditti is a physician with the Veterans Health Administration. She is a retired United States Army Colonel and holds a doctorate of osteopathic medicine. Dr. Venditti has a long history of public service. Her term will expire June 30, 2011.
