SUMMARIZED ALARM ORDINANCE - CITY CODE 6-15

The City of Mesa Police Alarm Ordinance (City Code 6-15-6) requirements:

- ❑ *Separate alarm permits are required* for the burglary (audible function) alarm and the Robbery/Panic (silent function) of the alarm system.
- ❑ Alarm permits renew annually at a fee of \$10.00 each.

The City of Mesa Police Alarm Ordinance (City Code 6-15-20) assessment and permit revocation information includes the following:

- ❑ Robbery/Panic systems are **allowed one (1) false alarm** per alarm permit year.
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$100.00 for the second false alarm.**
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$200.00 for the third false alarm and every subsequent false alarm** within the alarm permit year.
- ❑ Burglary systems will be subject to assessments beginning with the **first false alarm** during the alarm permit year.
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$50.00 for the first false alarm.**
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$100.00 for the second false alarm.**
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$150.00 for the third false alarm.**
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$200.00 for the fourth false alarm.**
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$250.00 for the fifth false alarm.**
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$300.00 for the sixth false alarm.**
Alarm Users will be **assessed \$400.00 for the seventh false alarm** and every **subsequent false alarm** within the permit year.

Miscellaneous Assessment Information:

- ❑ Multiple false alarms in a twenty-four (24) hour period by a common cause shall be deemed to be one (1) false alarm for assessment purposes.
- ❑ Any alarm system with **fifteen (15) or more false alarms** (burglary or robbery/panic) within an alarm permit year shall also be **subject to permit revocation. A written report of corrective action is required to avoid revocation of the alarm permit.**
- ❑ Assessments due to for any system problems or alarm company error will be subject to waiver consideration **upon receipt of written appeal by the alarm user or the alarm company and/or documentation of repairs completed.**
- ❑ The first burglary permit assessment due to human error can be waived if the alarm user successfully completes the City of Mesa Alarm Awareness Class prior to the first recorded false alarm, or if the alarm user successfully completes the class within 60-days after the first recorded false alarm.
