Solid Waste Utility Rate Recommendations

- No Residential Rate Increase
- Commercial Front Load Rates:
 - Trash: Overall 3.8% increase
- Commercial Roll Off Rates:
 - Trash: Overall 2% increase
 - Green Waste: Overall 11% increase
- Barrel Pullback Fee:
 - Increase from \$2.21 to \$10.00
