Vision Service Plan - ID Number Reminder

The City of Mesa contracts with Vision Service Plan (VSP) to deliver our vision benefit program. ID cards are not required or issued for this valuable employee benefit plan and service. However, when you or your covered family members visit a vision provider, let them know that your vision insurance is through VSP. Provide your unique member ID number so that the provider can verify your coverage and apply the VSP benefit levels to the services you receive. Your VSP unique member ID number is simply your City issued employee ID number preceded by 4 or 5 zeros to make a total 9-digit number. It is not your social security number - as may sometimes be the experience for other vision plan insurance that providers are used to dealing with.

Although ID cards are not issued/required, you have the option to either save, print, or email a personalized VSP ID card that includes you name, coverage type and copay information. Simply log into your VSP account at www.vsp.com and scroll down to the "Member ID Card" option and click on the "View Member ID Card" button. This is just for informational purposes and, again, is not required to be presented to your vision provider when receiving routine vision care services.
