EMERGENCY PLANNING AND PREPAREDNESS

International Fire Code 407.5 Hazardous Materials Inventory Statement.

Where required by the fire code official, each application for a permit shall include a Hazardous Materials Inventory Statement (HMIS) in accordance with Section 5001.5.2.

This documentation includes information such as the type and amount of specific hazards associated with the material and how it is used.

407.6 Hazardous Materials Management Plan.

Where required by the fire code official, each application for a permit shall include a Hazardous Materials Management Plan (HMMP) in accordance with Section 5001.5.1. The fire code official is authorized to accept a similar plan required by other regulations.

The HMMP is somewhat different from the HMIS in that it is geared to the layout of the building and the location and use of the hazardous materials. This document provides a better understanding of how the facility operates. This information in turn provides more detailed information to the emergency responders
