

- Full Pavement Replacement (US-60 to Enid Ave.)
- Pavement Rehabilitation (Enid Ave. to Pueblo Ave.)
- New Raised Median (US-60 to Southern Ave.)
- New Raised Median & Two Left Turn Lanes at the Val Vista Dr. and Southern Ave.
   Intersection
- New 6-ft Wide Sidewalk, Bike Lines and Portions of Concrete Curb & Gutter
- New ADA Concrete Sidewalk Ramps/Driveways




