- Public Meetings September 21 & 27
- Revised drive-thru regulation recommendation based on feedback
- City Council Study Sessions
  - October 13: Outdoor Eating Area & Drive-thrus
  - October 20: Temporary Use Permits
- Planning & Zoning Board
  - October 26: recommended approval on Temporary Use Permit and Outdoor Eating Area Amendments

#### Revised Recommendations





- Prohibit in the NC district
- Require an SUP in the LC district
- Require a CUP in the NC & LC Districts
  - Defining Pick-Up Windows and Drivethru Facilities differently

#### Revised Recommendations

- Set of base standards deviations may be requested through CUP
- No more than 2 drive-thrus in a group commercial center
- No more than 2 drive-thrus at an intersection



#### Revised Recommendations

- No more than 2 drive-thrus located adjacent to one another
- When there are 2 drive-thrus adjacent to each other, a 3rd drive-thru cannot be placed within 750 ft.
- Number based on the size of the group commercial center





# Outdoor Eating Areas



#### Recommendations

- Allow by right in all commercial districts
- Include development
  standards to guide outdoor
  eating area design



#### Temporary Use Permit



#### Recommendations





- Expand temporary use category, (i.e.,
  Christmas tree lots, haunted houses, fire works stands, parking lot sales etc.)
- 90 calendar days with ability for 1 time30-day extension

#### Recommendations

- Annual events may be granted3-year approval if alloperations remain the same
- Refine approval criteria and operational standards
