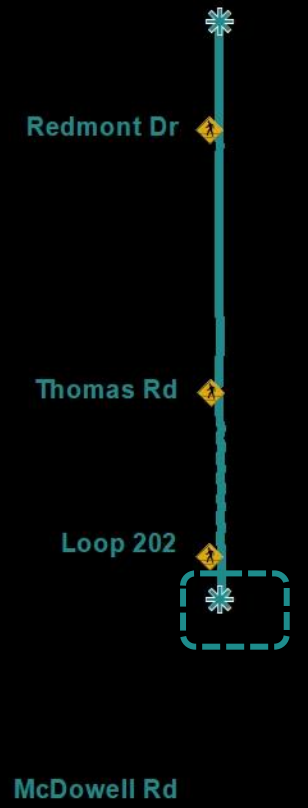

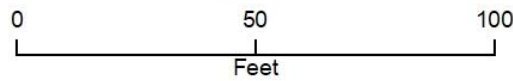

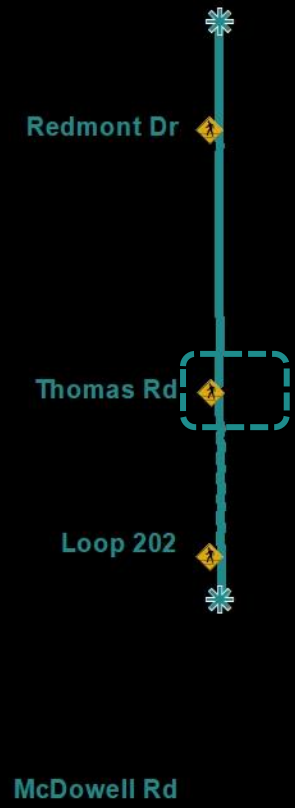
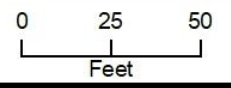
LOOP 202 FREEWAY OFFRAMP SIGNAL CROSSING

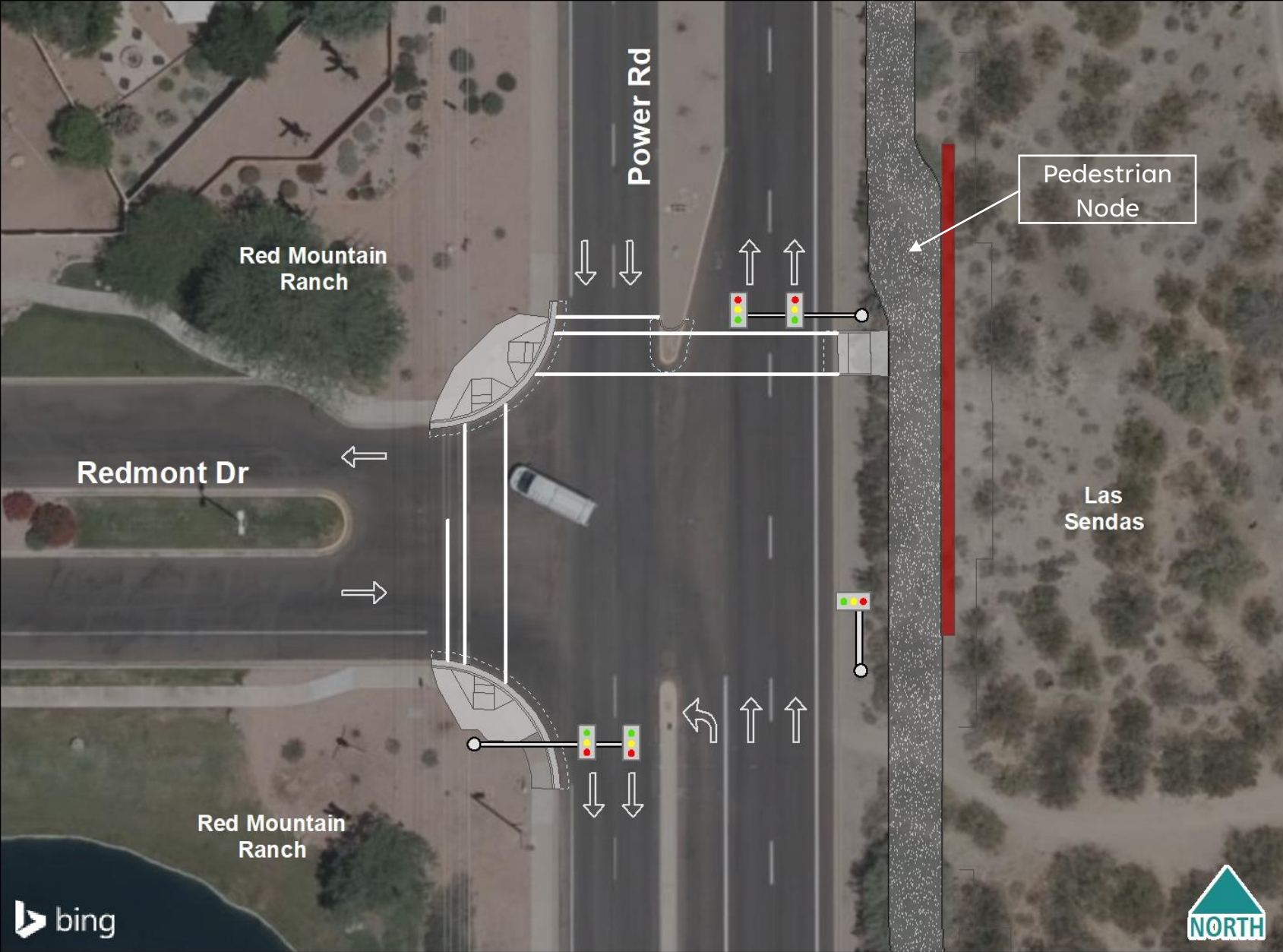

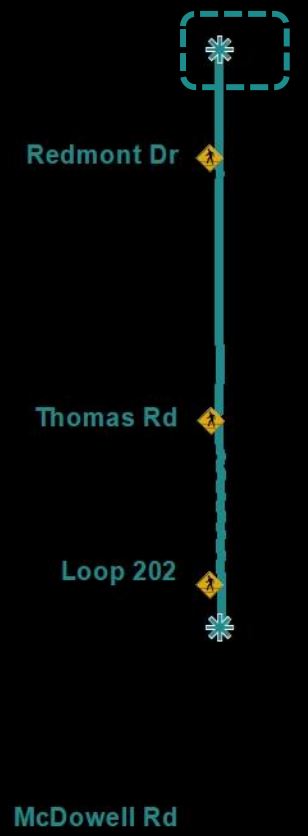

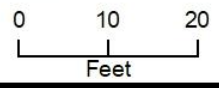

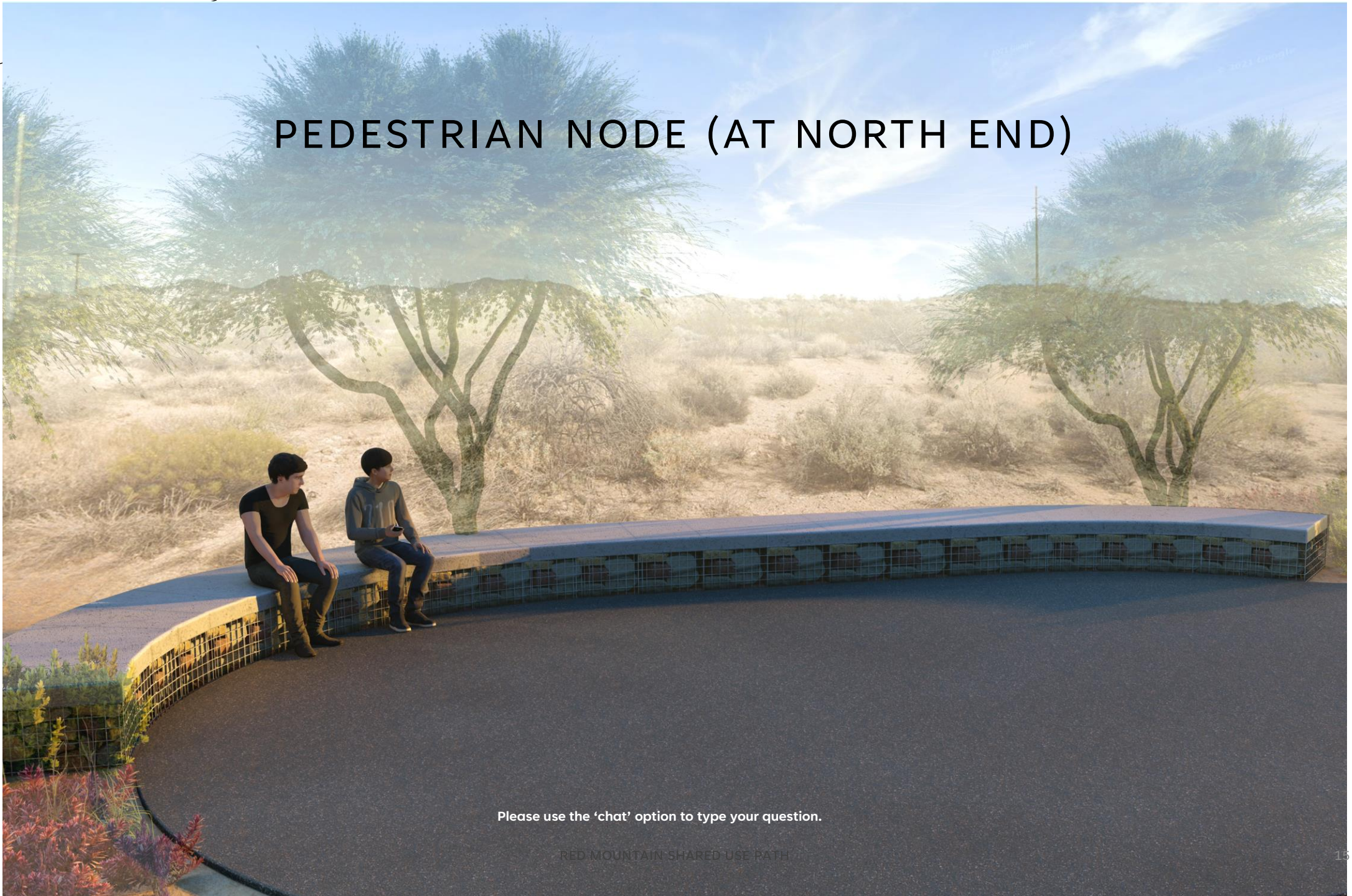
NORTH PEDESTRIAN NODE
