

# Arizona Ranks 43rd with a high prevalence of mental illness



### Police officers receive an influx of behavioral health crisis calls

### **Behavioral Crisis Calls**

Calls made when a mentally ill or troubled individual poses a threat to themselves or others.

### **Emergency Assistance**

Emergency calls, often disturbances, complaints, & suspicion.

### Crisis Intervention Team Training (CIT)

- 2 years after employment
- Recommend but not required
- For police officers



# Benefits of CIT Training





### **Recommendation:**

Patrol police officers must take CIT training after 2 years of employment and one training of continuing officer education per year to better address behavioral health crisis calls and community perceptions.
