RULES AND REGULATIONS (Pre-need)

A full copy of the Cemetery Rules and Regulations can be acquired at the office or online at www.mesacemetery.com.

- Prepayment of opening/closing fees is not allowed. These fees are to be paid at time of service.
- The City of Mesa will refund the amount originally paid for a returned grave(s) upon request (perpetual care fee is nonrefundable). There is an administrative fee to process a return of grave(s), a refund, exchange of grave(s), and transfer of ownership of grave(s).
- A concrete outer container is required for casket lengths over 48", purchased through the funeral home.
- A maximum of two interments can be placed in one grave, with the following options: one casket and one cremated remains, two cremated remains in a single grave, or two casket interments in a companion grave.
- Transfer of any interment rights must be approved by the City of Mesa and be filed with the Cemetery Office. There is an administrative fee to process transfers of interment rights.
- Grounds are flood irrigated from 1st to 12th Streets, and A to C Streets.

DECORATIONS

- All decorations must be placed in an approved permanent vase that is installed with the monument.
- Fences and Glass are strictly prohibited.
- The cemetery is not responsible for damage to or loss of porcelain photos, date plates, decorations, monuments or vases resulting from the elements, vandalism or theft.
- The City of Mesa reserves the right to remove decorations at any time that are deemed unsightly or weathered, or that interfere with grounds maintenance.
- Cemetery staff will remove Holiday decorations on dates that are posted on signs at entrances.

- Installation of monuments and vases must be performed by cemetery staff to ensure proper placement. The cemetery charges a fee for installation of monuments.

- Concrete borders on flat monuments are standard and are guaranteed for five years. After five years, there will be a fee for border replacement and marker removal.
- Flat monuments only are required in the Garden and Heritage Garden sections and olive/citrus tree areas.
- Flat or upright monuments are allowed in the Rolling Meadows and Original sections (except the olive/citrus tree areas).
- The North View section monuments can be upright or flat based on the designated row of grave purchased. Flat monuments are required if the grave purchased is in designated flat monument row. Upright monuments are required if the grave purchased is in designated upright monument row.
- Standard installation of monuments is facing East.

- Niche vases must be purchased through the City of Mesa for uniformity.

CREMATION CHECKLIST:

- Death Certificate, Transit Permit, or Certificate of Cremation required prior to or at time of interment.
- Urn Measurements are required prior to interment to ensure proper set up.
- Set up of one canopy and ten chairs is not included in the Cremation Opening and Closing fees. The set up can be added at an additional fee per our Schedule of Fees.
