The subject at issue in Propositions 101, 102, 103, and 104 was whether or not alcoholic beverages would be permitted at events held at Centennial Hall. The four propositions presented three options to voters: first, to permit alcoholic beverages at public and private events; second, to permit alcoholic beverages at private events only; or third, to ban alcoholic beverages from all events. The voters chose the third option, to amend the City Charter banning alcoholic beverages from all events held at Centennial Hall.
